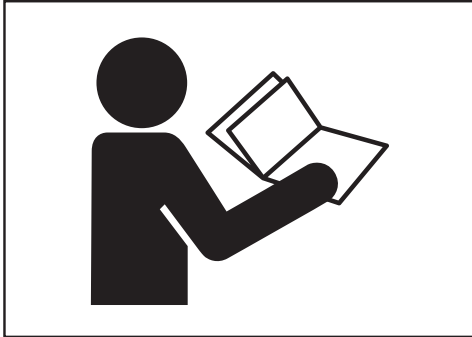




Safety Information for Fuel Cells

This page contains important safety information for those who handle fuel cells. Please read this information carefully and use the fuel cells safely.

READ AND UNDERSTAND THE INSTRUCTION MANUAL



Improper and unsafe use of a gas nailer/fuel cell may result in serious injury.

Please read the owner's manual enclosed with the product thoroughly before using any gas nailer/fuel cell.

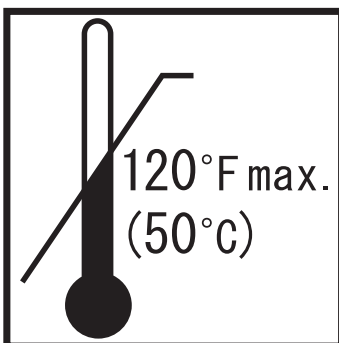

BE AWARE OF EXPLOSIVE AND FIRE HAZARD



Fuel cell is an aerosol dispenser with flammable contents under pressure. Failure to follow instructions may result in EXPLOSION OR FIRE.

STORE PROPERLY



Keep away from temperature over 120°F(5°C).
Do not store above 120°F(5°C).

STORE PROPERLY



Keep the fuel cell away from direct sunlight.



Keep the fuel cell away from a vehicle interior.



Do not expose to an open flame or sparks.



Keep out of the reach of children.



Store in well-ventilated area

STORE PROPERLY



Never use in presence of flammable liquids or gases. Do not use near flames or spray on heated surfaces. Keep away from ignition sources.



Do not smoke when handling the fuel cell.

DISPOSE OF PROPERLY



Pressured container and the propellant will remain in the fuel cell.

Do not damage, pierce, puncture, burn or open the fuel cell, even after use.

Dispose of according to local regulations for aerosol products. Do not refill, reclaim or recycle the fuel cell.

BE AWARE OF BODILY HAZARD



Do not inhale its contents.

Vaporizing gases cause extreme cold.

Fluid gases might cause injuries when getting in touch with skin or eyes.
